Collect of the Day (*Sunday next before Lent*)

Almighty Father, whose Son was revealed in majesty before he suffered death upon the cross: give us grace to perceive his glory, that we may be strengthened to suffer with him and be changed into his likeness, from glory to glory; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Psalm 50.1-6

¹ The LORD, the God of gods, has spoken; * he has called the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.

² Out of Zion, perfect in its beauty, * God reveals himself in glory.

³ Our God will come and will not keep silence; * before him there is a consuming flame, and round about him a raging storm. ⁴ He calls the heavens and the earth from above * to witness the judgment of his people.

⁵ "Gather before me my loyal followers, * those who have made a covenant with me and sealed it with sacrifice." ⁶ Let the heavens declare the rightness of his cause; * for God himself is judge.

Mark 9.2-9

² Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain apart, by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, ³ and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no one on earth could bleach them.

⁴ And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses, who were talking with Jesus. ⁵ Then Peter said to Jesus, 'Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.'

⁶ He did not know what to say, for they were terrified.

⁷ Then a cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, 'This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!'

⁸ Suddenly when they looked around, they saw no one with them any more, but only Jesus.

⁹ As they were coming down the mountain, he ordered them to tell no one about what they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead.
